There are two campuses for the University of Hertfordshire – College Lane and de-Havilland. The dance classes will be taking place at the **College Lane Campus**. You need to ensure you enter the University at the accommodation entrance rather than the main entrance (Postcode, AL10 8NB). See details below.

Public transport links to Hatfield

Hatfield station (two kilometres from the campus) is served by [First Capital Connect](#) trains from London Kings Cross (usual journey time 22 minutes), as well as local services from Cambridge and Peterborough.

Direct local trains run between Hatfield and Stevenage (journey time 15 minutes) connecting with Intercity services to the North.

There is a taxi rank and bus stop at the station for connections to the campuses (Buses 603, 341 and 641). A shuttle bus service operates regularly throughout the day between the College Lane and de Havilland campuses.

Alternatively, St Albans is a sixteen-minute bus journey from the University (Bus 602 or 655).

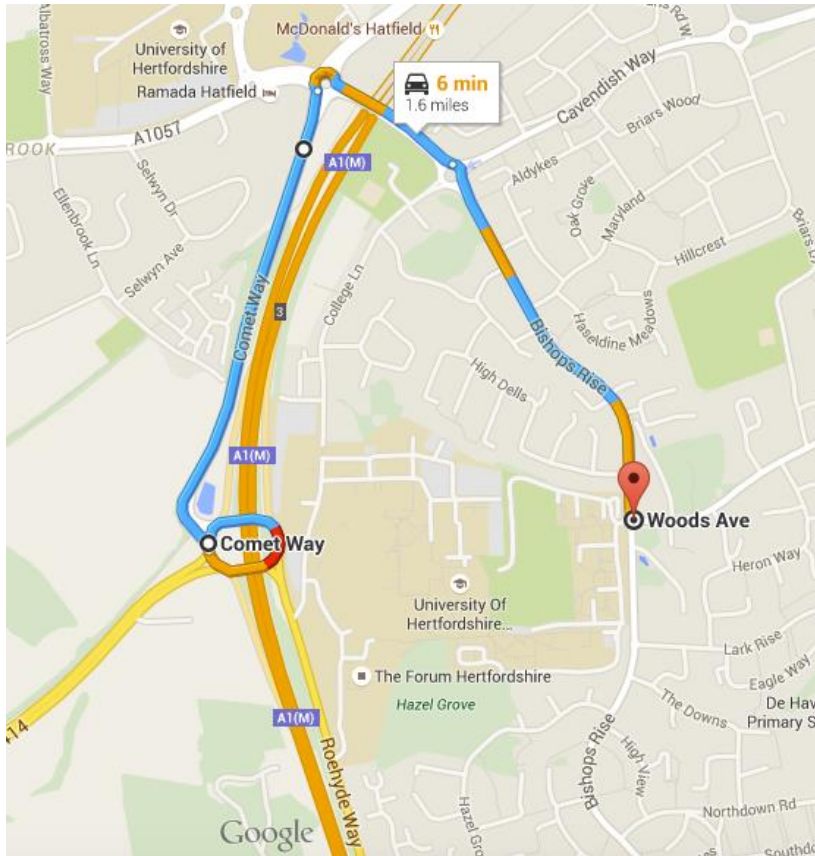
Travelling by car

From all directions on the M25, leave at junction 23. At the roundabout take the A1M (North), signposted towards Hatfield. Leave the A1M at junction 3.

From the A1M South, exit the motorway at junction 3.

From Junction 3 of the A1M, at the roundabout take the third exit onto Comet way and continue to the traffic lights. Take the third exit onto Cavendish way. Continue straight over the roundabout onto Bishops Rise. Continue straight up the hill and past the church. At the roundabout, take the third exit into the University accommodation entrance.

From St Albans, take the A414 towards Hatfield. At the roundabout for the A1, take the first exit onto Comet Way and continue to the traffic lights. Take the third exit onto Cavendish way. Continue straight over the roundabout onto Bishops Rise. Continue straight up the hill and past the church. At the roundabout, take the third exit into the University accommodation entrance.

Once at the University, follow the road around to the right, at the end of the road, there will be a member of the team to give you a parking permit and show you where to park.
