the relationship between art, architecture and nature is evident throughout the garden

The layout of the garden as a sequence of 'rooms' inspired Krijn de Koning to create a structure of dividing walls that acts to partition the space and draws attention to the relationship between the surrounding trees and the sculpture

- Overleaf the ARCHITECTURE has been drawn as a collage of fragmented walls - gaps between buildings, stairs, windows and doorways
- In each of the gaps you can add drawings of NATURE
- You may want to **draw** a view of a whole plant or close up on the detail of one or two leaves
- Think about the shape of **plants** and pick bold and striking forms
 - Fill the whole of each space taking the drawing right to the edge of the frames
 - Focus on the outline, working quite quickly to fill all the frames
 - Take your drawing home to colour







Make 2 **fold**s in the paper so that it divides into 3 even sections and unfold

The first person starts at the top and draws NATURE

Make it big in the space Fold back the paper so just the bottom edge shows so the next person can line up their drawing

The next person **draw**s **ART** - look at the shape of one of the many sculptures in the garden. **Fold** back the paper again

The final **draw**ing is **ARCHITECTURE**- this can be an element of a

structure in the garden
